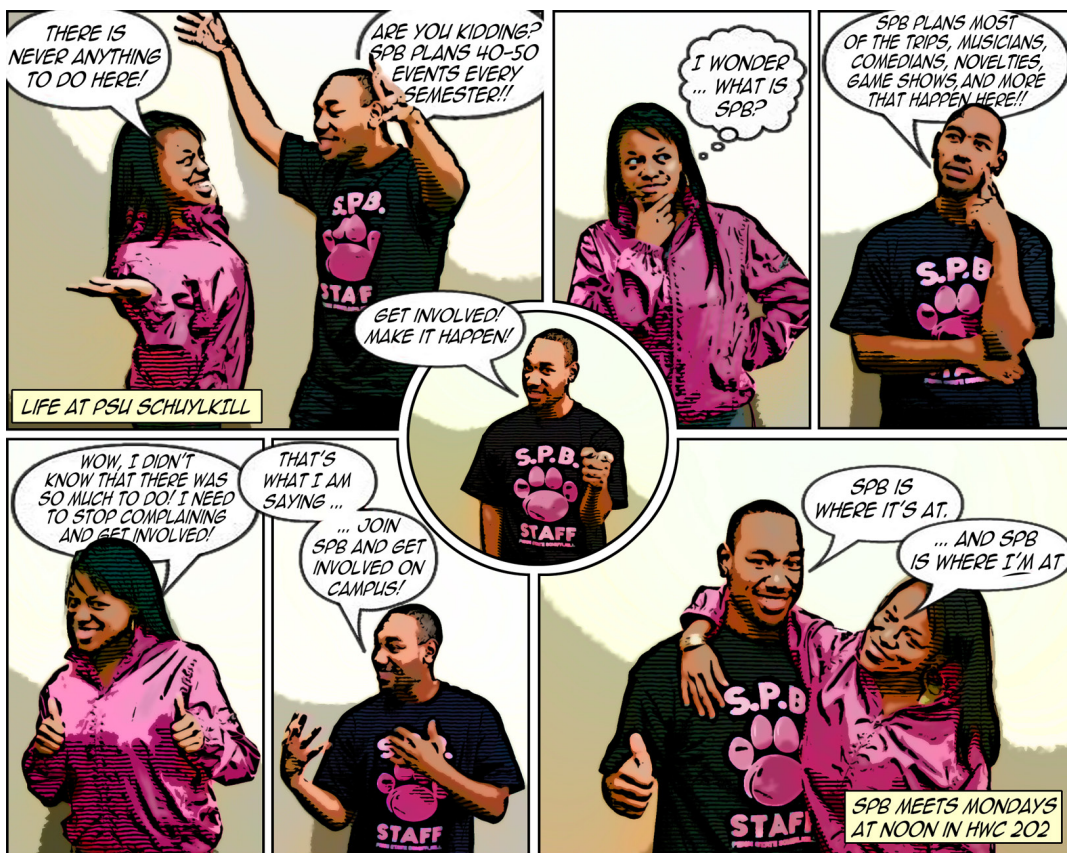


WHO IS ON THE CALENDAR COVER?
